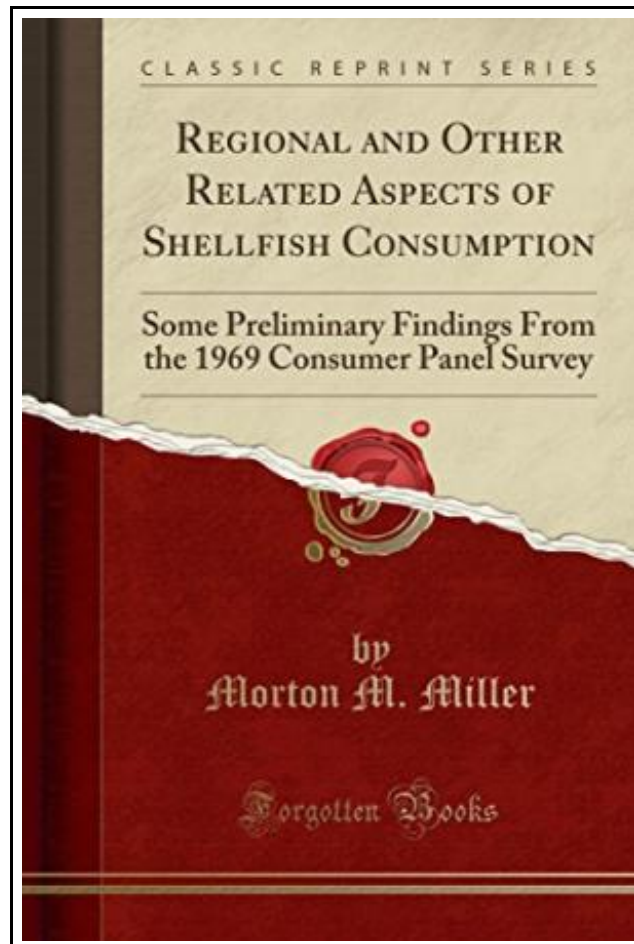

Age of consumer, too, has an apparent bearing on shellfish consumption as it was found that older consumers are the more disposed toward consumption of these products. With respect to consumption away from home, it appears that half or more of the crabs and lobsters are consumed in meals outside the home, but the majority consumed of other products was at home.
